- Universal healthcare

## Calculating the Cost

The Competitive Enterprise Institute, Power The Future, and the Wisconsin Institute for Law & Liberty partnered to calculate the cost of the Green New Deal to Wisconsin households, businesses, and farmers by estimating the cost of:

- Additional electricity demand
- Costs associated with shipping and logistics
- New vehicles
- Building retrofits
- Decreased crop yields
- Carbon tax on farmers

## The Cost to Wisconsin



More than **\$40,000 per household** every year.



**\$200 million** in losses to farmers.



**\$2.5 billion** to the dairy industry, or **\$2,000 per cow**.
