This matter having come before the Court on September 26, 2011 and based upon the briefs and arguments of counsel,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment is **granted** and that judgment be entered in favor of the Plaintiffs and against the Defendants declaring that consideration of decennial redistricting at the April 21, 2011 meeting of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors violated the open meetings law, Wis. Stat. § 19.81 et seq.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that judgment is entered against the Defendant Lee Holloway in the amount of \$300.00 and against the Defendant Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors in the amount of \$300.00 for forfeitures under § 19.96, awarded to the Plaintiff State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that judgment is entered against the Defendants in the amount of \$9,718.80 for costs and attorney fees, awarded to the Relator Joseph A. Rice as follows:
