

Expanding Educational Options

EVERY CHILD DESERVES TO ACCESS A HIGH-QUALITY SCHOOL

The pandemic highlighted the reality that far too many Wisconsin students do not have access to a high-quality educational option. AB 970 removes barriers to the parental choice programs and empowers parents to customize their child's education in 2022-2023.

AB 970 expands educational options by:



Removes the income limitations for the Wisconsin, Racine and Milwaukee Parental Choice Programs so all families have access to high-quality schools.



Ends the pupil participation limit which currently prevents students in six districts across the state from participating in the choice program.



Helps more students access the parental choice program and makes it easier for private schools to expand the number of seats for choice students.



Provides reimbursement to parents for educational expenses, including curriculum and textbooks, for the 2022-2023 school year.



Provides funding for students to access classes at participating private and tribal K-12 schools, institutions of higher education and other approved educational providers.
