**ALTERNATIVE WRIT OF MANDAMUS**

To the above-named Defendant, Wisconsin Parole Commission:

It appears on the application of Wisconsin Right Now, LLC, of 5546 Donegal Road, Hubertus, Wisconsin, 53033, and the supporting affidavits of Jessica McBride and Jim Piwowarczyk, now on file in the Office of the Clerk of Courts for Washington County, that Plaintiff in May, 2022, filed a lawful public records request pursuant to the Wisconsin Open Records Law, Wis. Stat. § 19.31, *et seq.*, and, that you partially fulfilled that request on June 17, 2022, and at that time you also stated you were still gathering and would provide the remaining

records which were requested, and nevertheless, you have unjustifiably withheld and refused to release those remaining records to which Plaintiff is entitled, to the injury of Plaintiff.

Therefore, so that speedy justice should be done on Plaintiff's behalf,

YOU ARE HEREBY COMMANDED to, immediately on receipt of this writ, release the remaining records responsive to Plaintiff's May, 2022 request for public records, which you told them you were gathering and would provide via your June 17, 2022 e-mail to the Plaintiff, or in the alternative, to show cause to the contrary before this Court, in Room 2254 (Branch 3) at the Washington County Courthouse, 484 Rolfs Avenue, West Bend, Wisconsin 53095 on **October 28, 2022 at 8:30AM** or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard.

This writ shall be served upon the Defendant within fourteen days of its issuance or it shall be deemed void.

You have received this writ. Return your execution of it, or provide a reason why you cannot or will not perform as commanded above.
