PROPOSED ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

On June 21, 2024, Plaintiffs filed a motion for a temporary restraining order and a temporary injunction. Having reviewed the materials submitted by the Plaintiffs, the Court finds good cause for a temporary restraining order. NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 813.02 and 813.025, Defendants are hereby enjoined from enforcing the Village of Sister Bay's short-termrental ordinances against the Plaintiffs or otherwise prohibiting them from renting their property at 10775 N.
